Entrance Age

Preschool Special Education	Resident students entering Preschool Special Education must have reached the age of 3 years prior to enrollment.
Pre-School Education	 All other students must have reached the age of 4 by the starting date of the regular school year to attend preschool, but kindergarten age restrictions will remain indicated below.
Kindergarten	 Resident students entering kindergarten must have reached the age of 5 years on or before June 1st of the school year in which they enroll. Kindergarten students transferring into the Kit Carson School from another kindergarten program shall be eligible for kindergarten enrollment.
First Grade	 Resident students entering first grade must have reached the age of 6 years on or before June 1st of the school year in which they enroll. Transfer students who have successfully completed a one-year kindergarten program in a public or non-public school, and who have met the minimum are requirements for kindergarten admission in the originating district, shall be eligible for first grade enrollment.
New Students	 Pre-register your students at school any time during the summer before first day of school August 20th, 2015. 9:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m.
